<p><b>Internal assessment (10 minutes): Interactive skills</b></p> <p><b>Individual oral (25 marks)</b>            Three-part oral internally assessed by the teacher and externally moderated by the IB towards the end of the course.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Part 1: Presentation of a visual stimulus (from a choice of two) by the student</li> <li>• Part 2: Follow-up questions on the visual stimulus</li> <li>• Part 3: General conversation including at least two questions on the written assignment</li> </ul>	<p><b>25%</b></p>
